MICKEY MUG



MATERIALS

- Mini lodge mug (SKU G4076)
 - Fan brush
- Medium round brush
- Small detail brush
 - Tape
 - dish soap
 - Tablespoon
- Straw (re-usable)
 - Pencil
- Mickey template
- Tracing paper
 - Paint:
62, 85, 46, 98, 31, 67, 27

TIPS

- Mix water and paint before adding dish soap.
- Allow bubbles to pop on their own.
 - Let the paint dry completely between coats.
- This technique can be applied to most mugs, as well as cups or tumblers skipping the mickey arm.

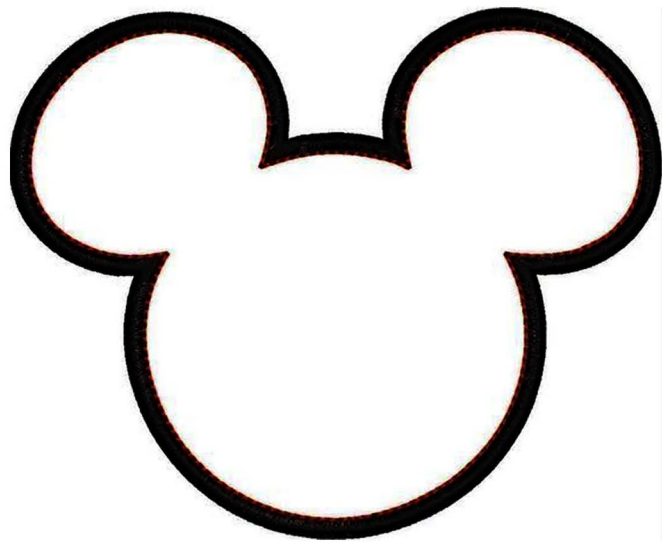
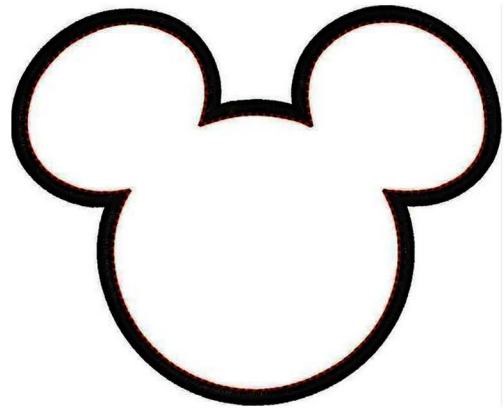
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INSTRUCTIONS

1. Wipe mug clean with damp sponge.
2. Paint the inside and the rim of the mug with the fan brush and #62. (2 coats, allow to dry between coats.)
3. Tape along the bottom of the cup right beneath the handle.
4. With the handle facing to the left, use tape to make a triangle with the pointy part on top.
5. Tape along the middle of the cup starting from one side of the triangle ending on the other side of the triangle.
6. Tape around the handle a fourth of the way up. (This will be your mickey arm and glove.)
7. Paint the top portion of the mug with a medium round brush and #62. (2 coats, allow to dry between coats. Avoid painting in the triangle and handle.)
8. Make bubble mix with 4 tablespoons of water, 2 tablespoons of paint (#85), and a drop of dish soap. Mix well. Using a straw blow gently into the mix to create bubbles.
9. Apply bubbles to the painted part of the mug.
10. Gently peel off tape closest to the top. With a lightly damp sponge wipe away any paint in the section under the painted area.
11. Using a small round brush and #98 paint between the painted area and the bottom tape. (3 coats, allow to dry between coats. Avoid painting in the triangle and handle.)
12. Gently peel off tape that creates the triangle. With a lightly damp sponge wipe away any paint in the triangle.
13. With a medium round brush and #46 paint the triangle. (3 coats, allow to dry between coats.)
14. Gently peel off the bottom tape. With a lightly damp sponge wipe away any paint in the bottom portion and the handle.
15. Paint the bottom portion with #27 using a small round brush. (3 coats, allow to dry between coats. Avoid painting the handle.)
16. Tape the Mickey Template over tracing paper and trace onto the mug. (If the tracing is difficult to see, gently go over it with a pencil.)
17. Paint Mickey with a small round brush and #31.
18. Add 3 horizontal line accents with #31 and a small detail brush midway onto the triangle making one line longer than the other with the top being the shortest. (3 coats, allow to dry between coats.)
19. Paint the top portion of the handle with a medium round brush and #31. (3 coats, allow to dry between coats.)
20. Gently peel off tape on the handle. Paint the bottom of the handle with #67 and a small round brush. (3 coats, allow to dry between coats.)
21. With a small detail brush and #31 paint the accent lines on Mickey's glove. (3 coats, allow to dry between coats.)
22. Create the illusion of Mickey's buttons by dipping your index finger into #67 paint and applying them on red part of your mug.
