MATERIALS

DB37469 - Squrve Dessert Plate
#1 Long Liner Brush
#1 Short Liner Brush
#6 Round Brush
Writer Bottle
Medium Writer Bottle Tip
Pencil
Water-Based Marker
Tissue Paper

COLORS

CMM93 - London Fog CMM12 - Mocha Java CMM88 - Vanilla Bean CMM31 - Licorice CMM67 - Snow Flake

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Wipe a damp sponge over the entire plate to remove dust and contaminants.
- 2. Trace the pattern and lettering onto the tissue paper with a pencil.
- 3. Place the tissue paper over the plate and trace over the pencil lines with a dark water-based marker. Hold onto the tissue carefully so that the design doesn't shift as you trace.
- 4. Paint 3 coats of London Fog on the ears, forehead, body, and every other tail stripe.
- 5. Paint 3 coats of Mocha Java on the eye mask and every other tail stripe.
- 6. Paint 3 coats of Vanilla Bean on the nose and mouth area.
- 7. Paint 3 coats of Licorice on the eyes and nose.
- 8. With a liner brush, paint 1 thick coat of Licorice for the whiskers.
- 9. Add dots with Snow Flake on the eyes for eyes shine and a swoop on the nose for glare.
- 10. Fill a writer bottle with some Licorice.
- 11. With the writer bottle and medium tip, trace over the lettering.

TIPS

- Allow paint to dry between coats.
- Wash brush between colors.
- Use a contrasted colored marker to make the pattern more visible as you are painting.
- Use masking tape to hold the tissue paper while you are tracing if it shifts.
