

BUNNY BOWL

Simple Techniques - Stunning Effects



MATERIALS

DB37209 Bunny Dish
Detail Brush
Medium Brush
Liner Brush
Small Sponge Dabber

COLORS

CMM 31- Licorice CMM 16 - Chiffon CMM 93 - London Fog CMM 19 - Banana Boat CMM 76 - Lemon Mist CMM 44 - Battleship CMM 67 - Snowflake



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Use a detail brush to paint inside the ears, and the pads of the feet with 3 coats of Chiffon.
- 2. Paint the bowl section with 3 coats of Lemon Mist.
- 3. Paint in the bunny with 3 coats of London Fog.
- 4. Dip the sponge dabber into Banana Boat and tap off the excess paint. Then, apply the dots to the bowl, repeat with a second coach.
- 5. Use a detail brush to outline the eyes, mouth, and fill in the nose with a heavy coat of Battleship.
- 6. Fill in the eyes with 2 coats of Licorice.
- 7. Water down Battleship with 50% water to 50% paint. Sweep in shaded areas around the arms and lefts, and to the back of the ears. Use water to blend it out into the lighter grey.
- 8. Dip the back of the detail brush into Snowflake and tap a highlight onto each eye.

TIPS

- Make sure to tap of the excess paint from the sponge dabber so that you get an even circle.
- You can use a brush with just water in it to brush over the Battleship shadows if you want to dilute.
