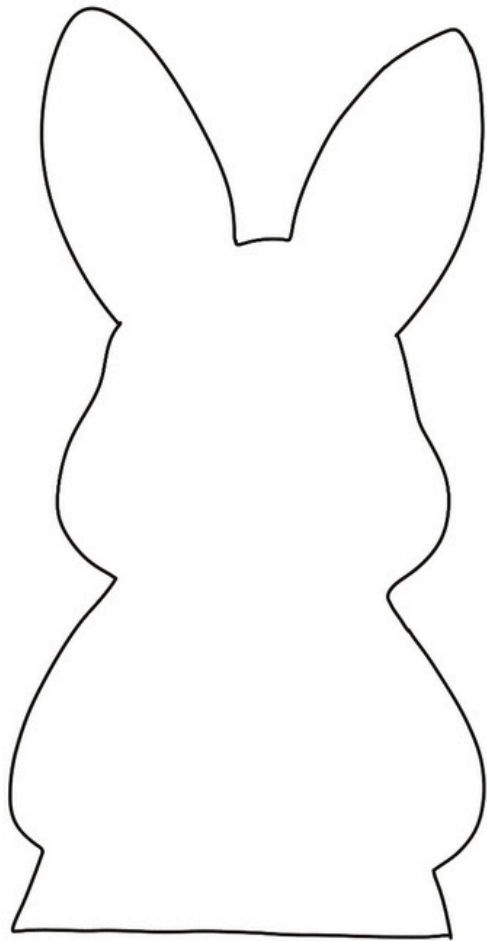
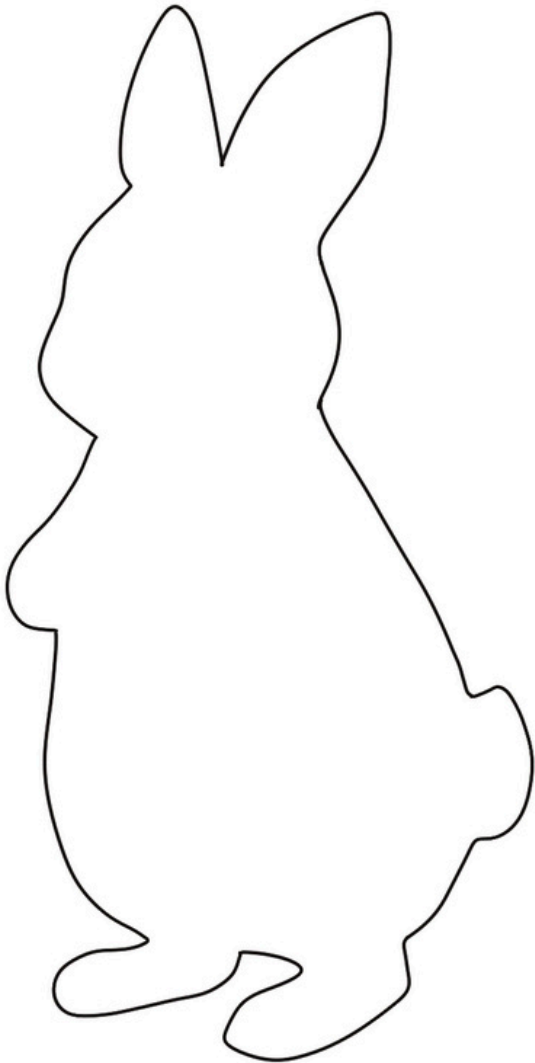
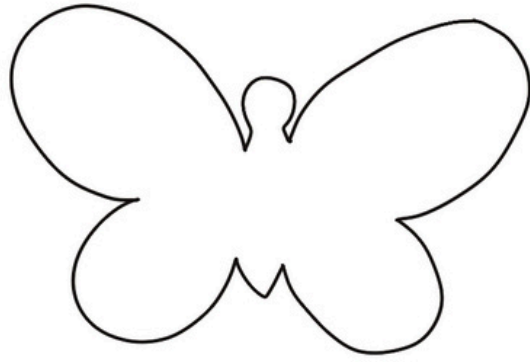

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Paint 2 coats of Vanilla Bean on the whole vase besides the pages.
2. Paint a wash of Sahara on the pages using 50/50 paint to water.
3. Trace the outline of the bunny on the front of the vase in the center while making sure to leave room around it for the carrots.
4. Fill in the outline of the bunny with 3 coats of Cinnamon Stick.
5. Paint 3 coats of Sahara inside the ear, around the eyes, nose, and mouth, on the chest, on the belly, tail, and where the ends of all feet would be except for the right hand that's over the bag strap. We'll add that in later.
6. Next, paint 3 coats of Carnation on the inside of the ear and make sure to stay inside where you already painted Sahara to leave an outline.
7. Paint the nose in 3 coats of Carnation.
8. Paint the shape of the bag including the strap in 3 coats of Mocha Java.
9. Now, paint the right hand in 3 coats of Sahara over the bag strap.
10. Paint in the rough shape of all the carrots in the bag in 3 coats of Carrot Juice. Just do a rough shape of all the carrots together because they will get outlined later.
11. Paint the leaves on the carrots in 3 coats of Guacamole. Choose where some of the carrots are gonna go in the outline and just add the leaves on top. Does not have to be perfect because it can be fixed with the outlining.
12. Add in the eyes with 2 solid coats of Licorice.
13. Paint a dot and line in each eye with the color Snowflake.
14. Using a small liner brush and watered down Mississippi Mud that's 80/20 paint to water, add in outlines and details to the whole bunny including the bag and carrots. They shouldn't be perfect and in places like around the head, ears, chest, belly, and tail you can add fur like details. Make sure to add an outline around the eyes to make it look more cohesive.
15. For the carrots it is helpful to draw rough outlines of them to get the spacing right. Make sure to leave enough room between them for the leaves but also making them all equally spaced apart. They should be in an oval shape around the bunny.
16. Fill in the carrot outlines with 2 thin coats of Carrot Juice.
17. With a small liner brush, paint the leaves in watered down Guacamole that's 80/20 paint to water. Add 2-3 stems per carrot.
18. Outline just the carrot and not the leaves with the color Pumpkin Pie. A single, thin coat will do.
19. Lastly, write the words "Storybook Garden" on the spine of the book with a writer bottle filled with Mississippi Mud.
